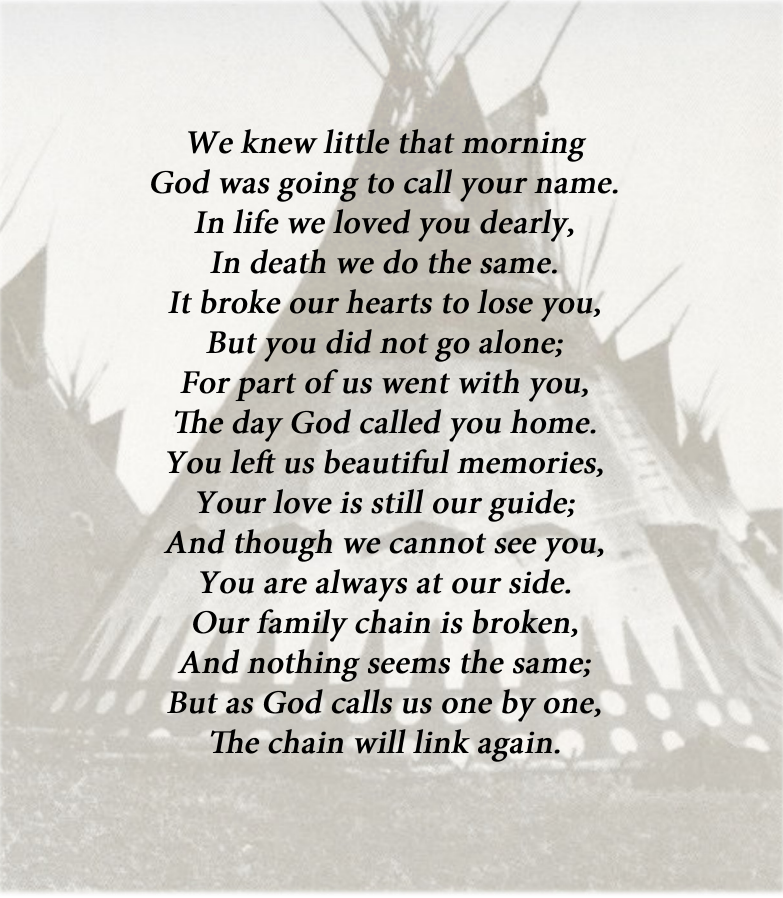




We knew little that morning

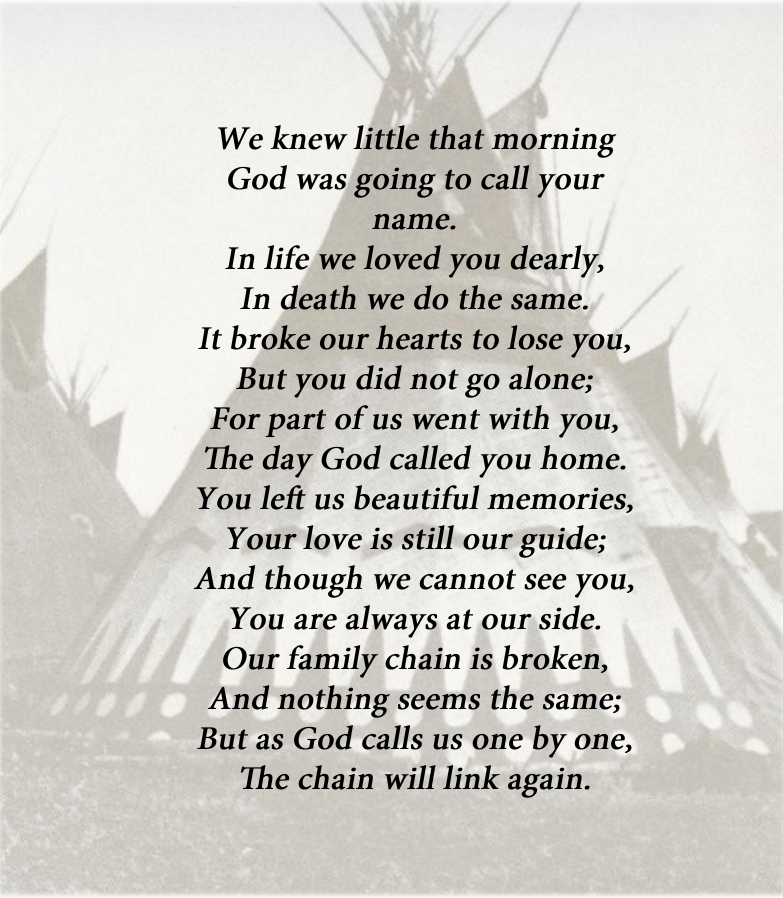
