He worked at the grain terminals in Saskatchewan before pursuing carpentry. Prior to his illness, Wayne worked in maintenance for Fishing Lake First Nation and served as a janitor at Chief Sabitawasis School. He was also a Band Councillor & Trustee for the 1907 Surrender Trust. He was brutally honest.

More than anything, Wayne cherished his family. His grandson, Jensen, was his pride and joy and constant little sidekick.

Wayne was predeceased by his parents, Betty and John, and his siblings Bob, May, Hazel, Stanley, Gordon, David, Mike, Joyce, and Rose.
