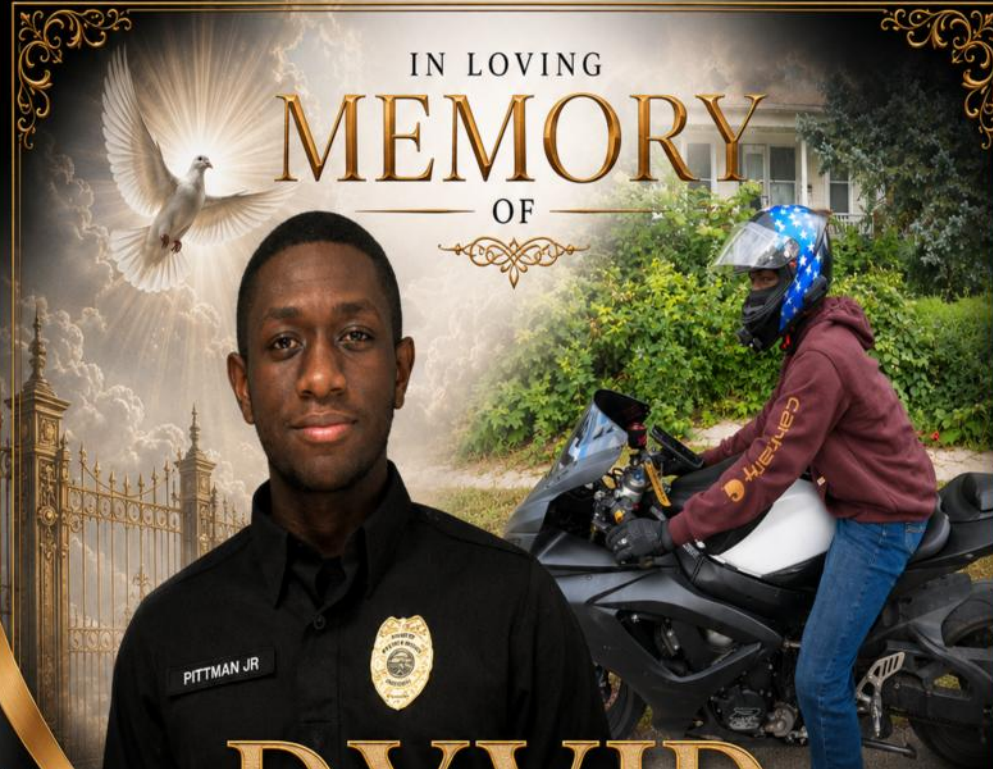
My Son
