Paul J. Litton, 64, of Concordia, MO, passed away on Sunday, May 11, 2025, at Boone Hospital Center in Columbia, MO. He was born on November 6, 1960, in St. Louis, MO, the son of Charles Edward Litton and Anna Marie (Murphey) Litton, who preceded him in death.

On May 5, 1979, in Sweet Springs, MO, he was united in marriage to Diana L. Loges, who resides in the home.

Paul was a graduate of the Sweet Springs High School class of 1979. He worked at his father's Litton Shell Station in Sweet Springs and also served as a tree trimmer for Shade Tree and Asplundh Tree Service. Recently, Paul retired from ConAgra Foods in Marshall, MO, after 25 years of service.
