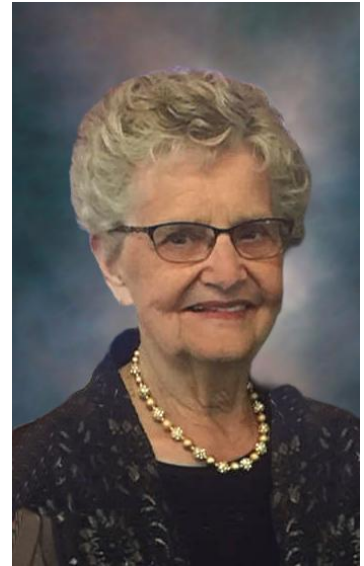


# Margaret M. Abts
