Throughout her life, Marilyn has lovingly touched many people's lives and she has earned their highest respect and love. She has become the role model for both of her South Dakota and Arizona families and she serves as a reminder and example of what dedication to family and unconditional love for one another embodies. Her family and friends are stronger and blessed by the life she has lived.
