Obituary

Theodora Green, beloved mother, grandmother, missionary, and evangelist, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, June 12th, 2024, with her sons by her side. Theodora or “Teddy”, as many of her friends knew her, was the youngest of three children born to Theodore and Priscilla Green of South Carolina.

Theodora was educated in the Boston Public School system and graduated from Brighton High School. She went on to receive an associate’s degree from Grahm Jr. College. She later pursued a career in healthcare and became a licensed practical nurse. Theodora then chose to complete her education by attending Curry College and received her Bachelor of Arts in Management and her Bachelor of Science in Nursing. She worked as a registered nurse and professional legal nurse consultant throughout the Suffolk and Middlesex areas.
