In August 1986, Mike was united in marriage to Deborah Osborne and to this union two children were born Michele and Daniel.

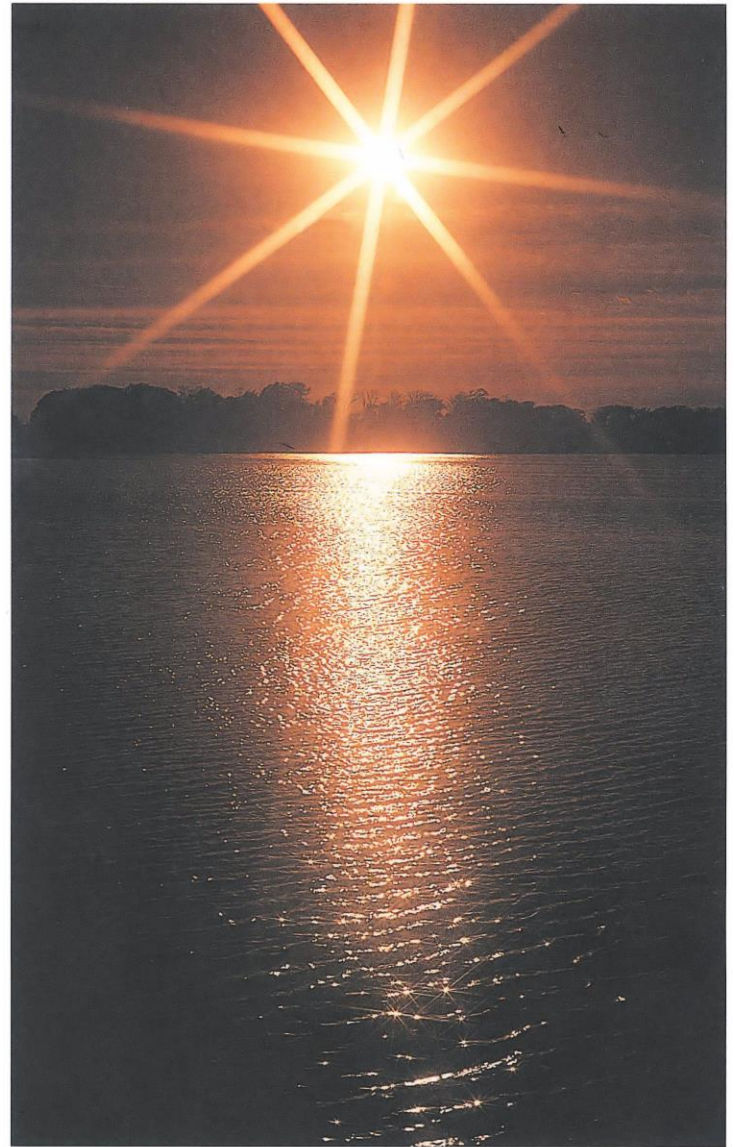
