Until we meet again.*

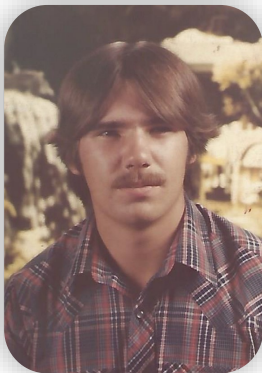
