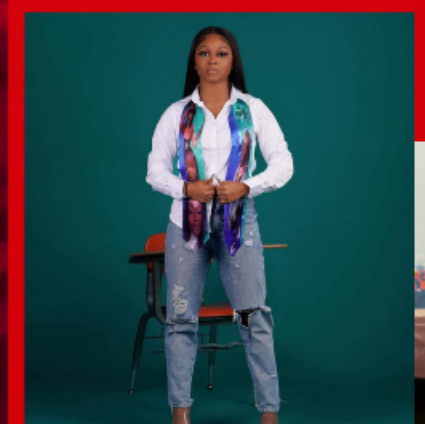
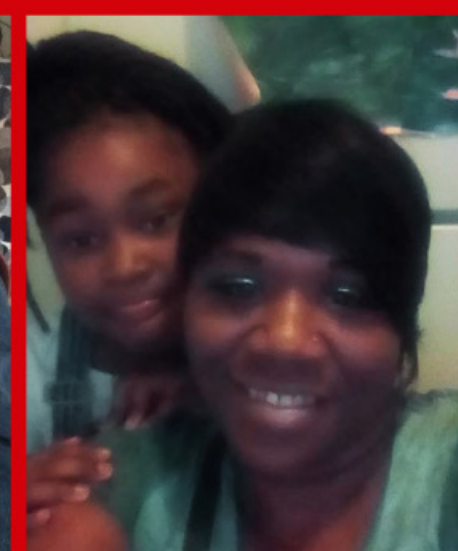
Remembering Auntie
