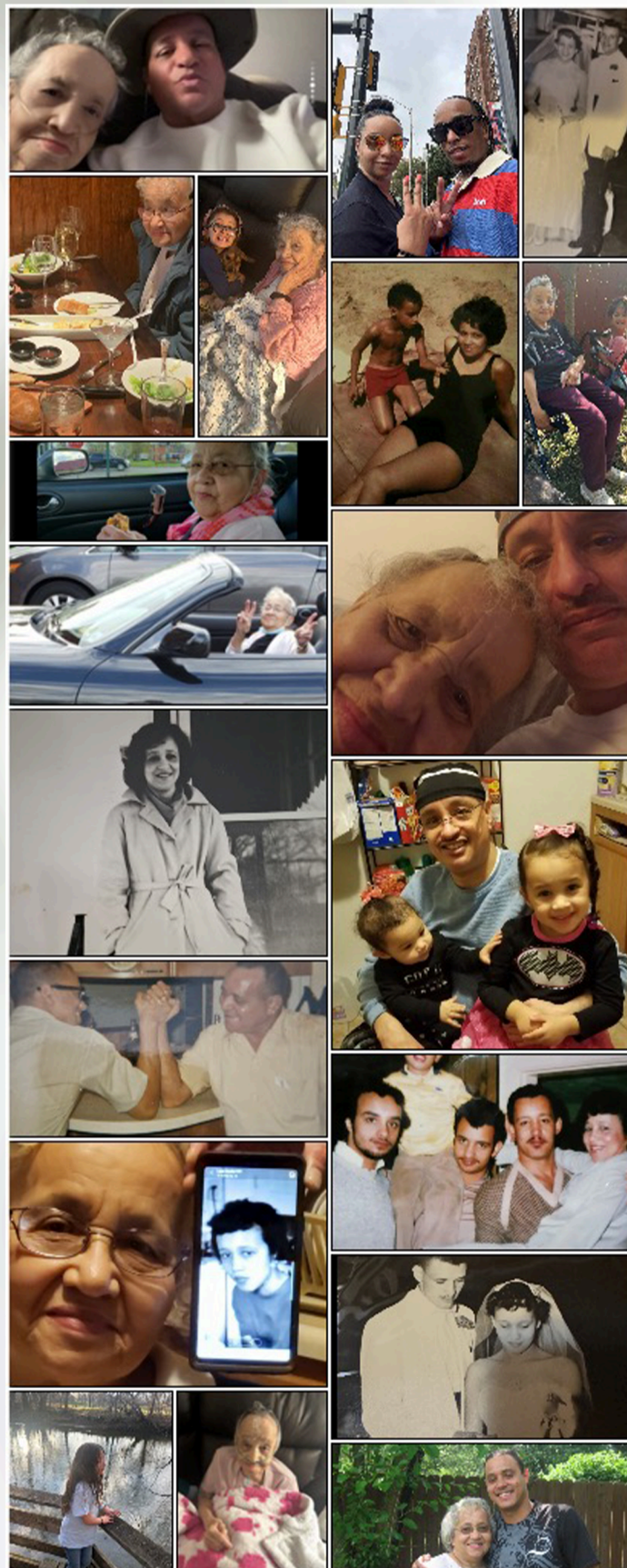
A Life to Celebrate
