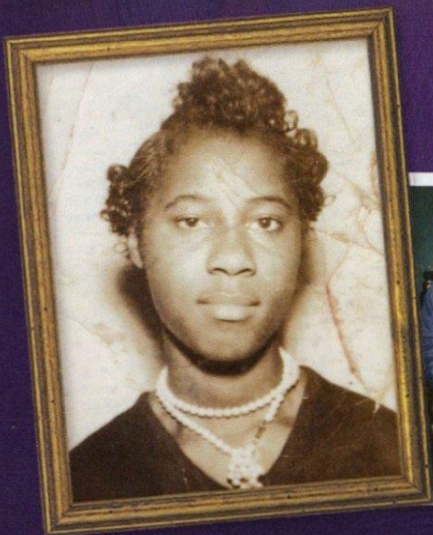


Obituary

Carolyn was intelligent, independent, and assertive. She kept up with current events and was a great conversationalist. She loved her family and was very supportive and non-judgmental.

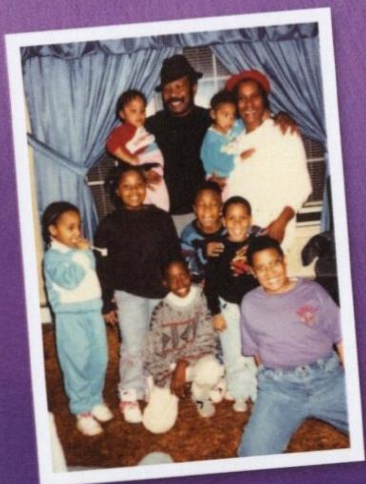
