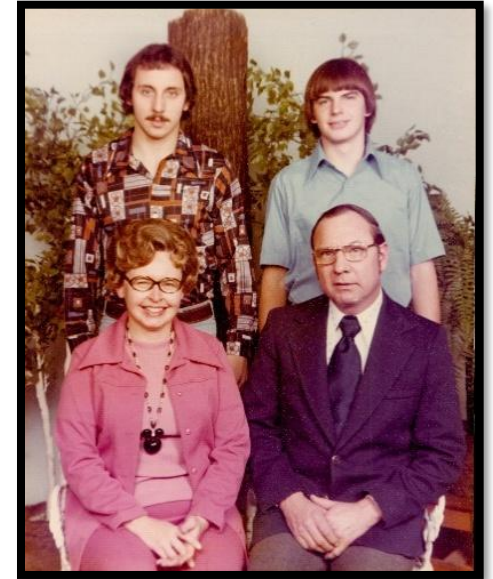


marriage to Vernon Ratcliff, in Clarion, Iowa. Viola worked as a bookkeeper and was also a devoted homemaker.
