Mother Helen was a fun and happy woman, and she has made some Great Memories!

In 1968, Helen heard the Lord's call: "Put that bottle down. You've served the devil long enough. Now, how about serving Me?" From that moment on, she pressed forward in faith. Many family members and friends followed Mother Helen to church, where she shared God's word and helped lead souls to salvation. (Matthew 5:14-16)

Helen received her education at Harriet Beecher Stowe and dedicated herself to serving her community.
