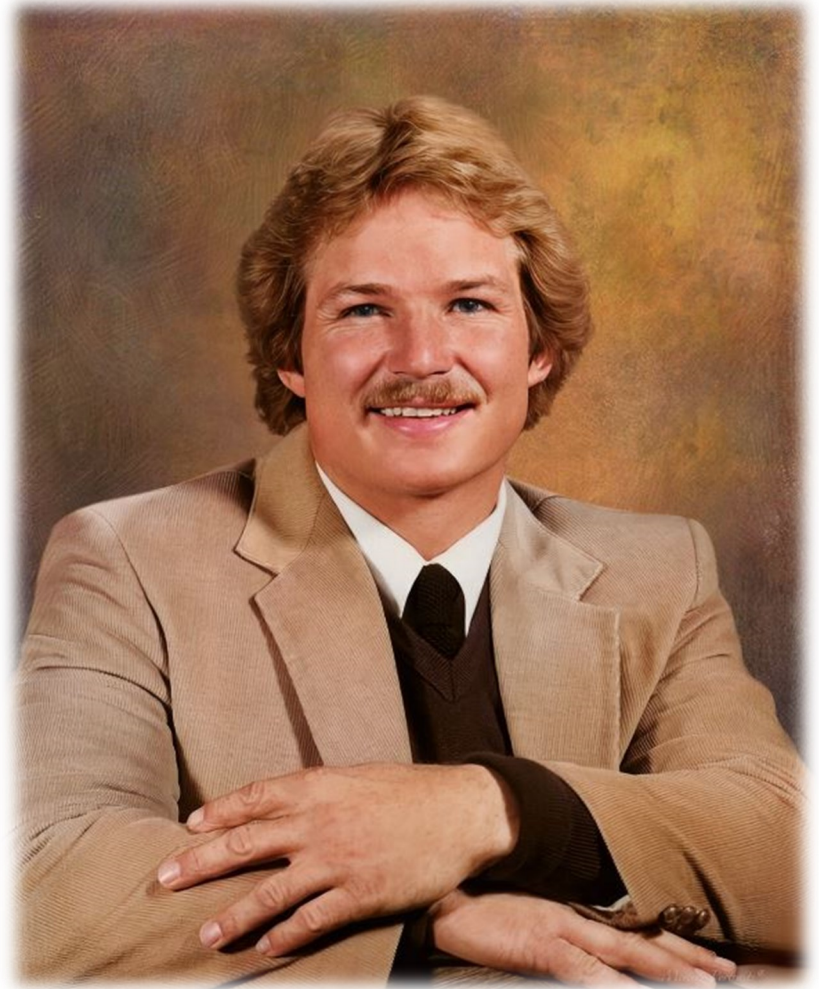
Mike later dedicated 32 years of service as a Special Police Officer at Pantex, where he built a respected career marked by commitment and integrity.
