During the summer months of his childhood he enjoyed attending Indian Falls Creek with his family and cousins. Last July of 2023, he made plans for Rachel and him to attend a Wednesday evening service at Falls Creek. They both enjoyed being there for the worship time and being with the family.

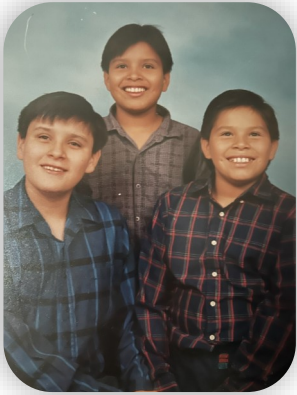
