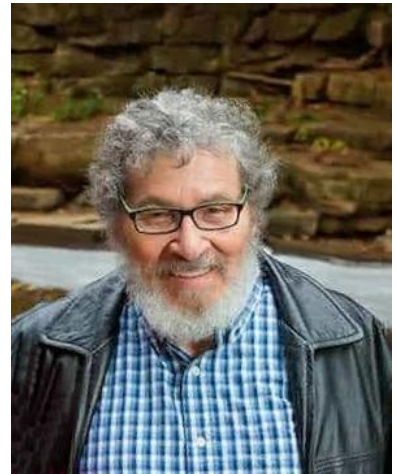


Leonard D. Jensen
