

Dick Levenson, 94, of Fargo, North Dakota, passed away Monday, February 2, 2026, peacefully under the care of Hospice.

Richard (Dick) Arlen Levenson was born in Fargo, North Dakota on March 5, 1931, to C.O. & Bessie (Moe) Levenson. He attended Roosevelt Middle School, and graduated from Fargo Central High School in 1949. He served in the US Air Force from 1951 through 1954, stationed at Fairchild Air Force Base, Spokane, Washington.

Dick married Bev Hanson on August 11, 1962 at Perry Lutheran Church in rural Portland, North Dakota. He was a lifelong Fargo resident.

Dick graduated from North Dakota State University (NDAC at the time) in 1958 with a Bachelor of Architecture degree, and was a Registered Architect. He worked at several architecture offices in Fargo, retiring from R.L. Engebretson Architects.
