A time to Rest

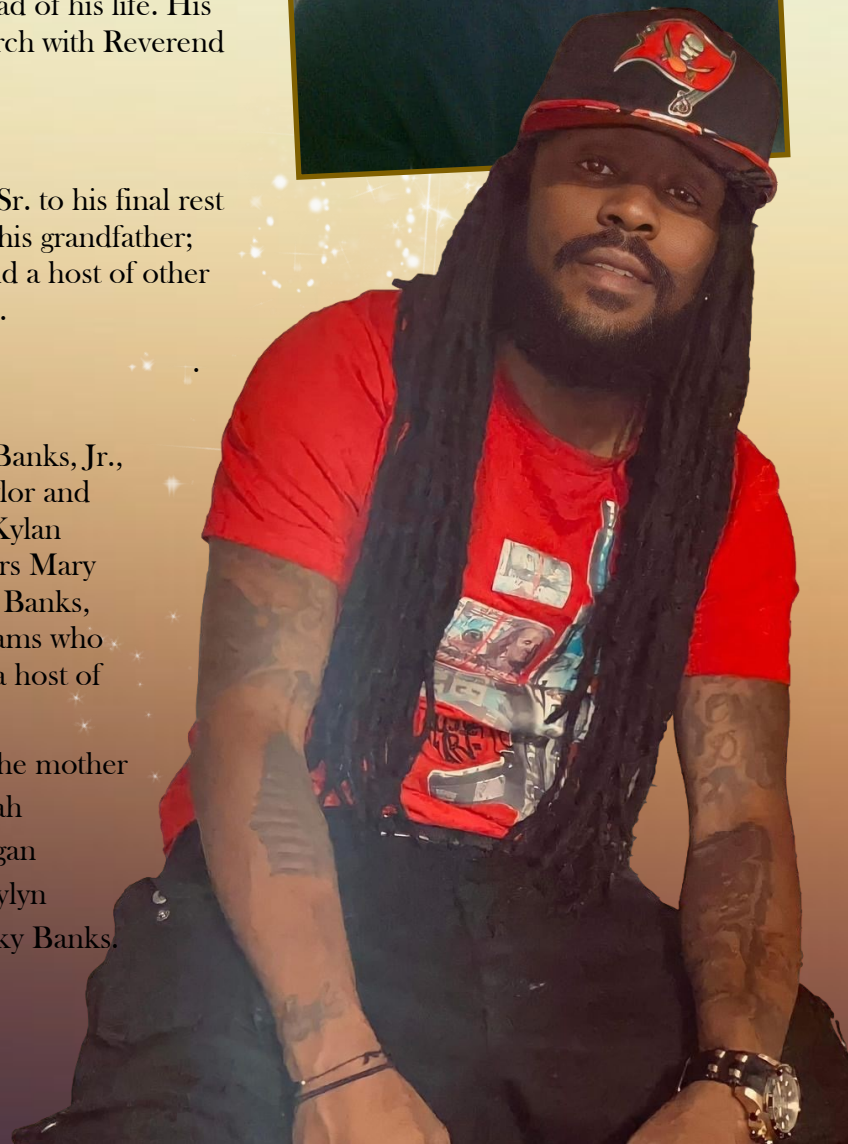

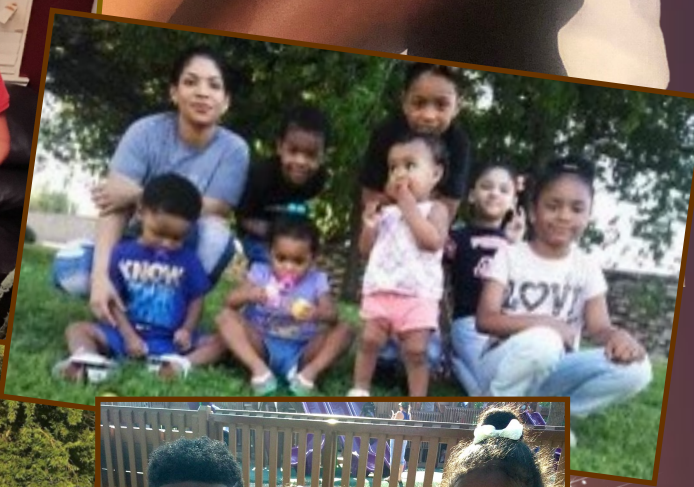

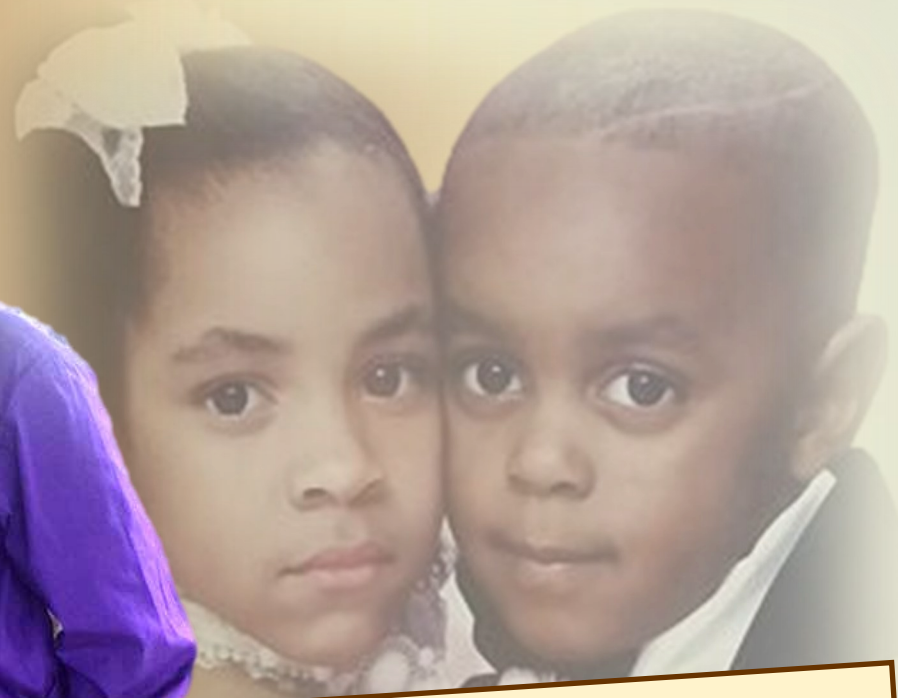
