At the age of 12, James professed his faith in Christ, and was Baptized at Second missionary Baptist church under the leadership of Reverend Dr. Earl Miller.

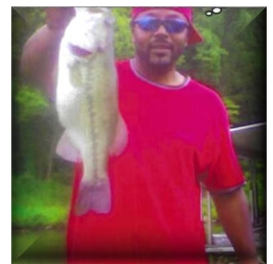
James was educated at O'Fallon tech high school and later attended Vatterott College, where he obtained a Certificate as a Master Welder.

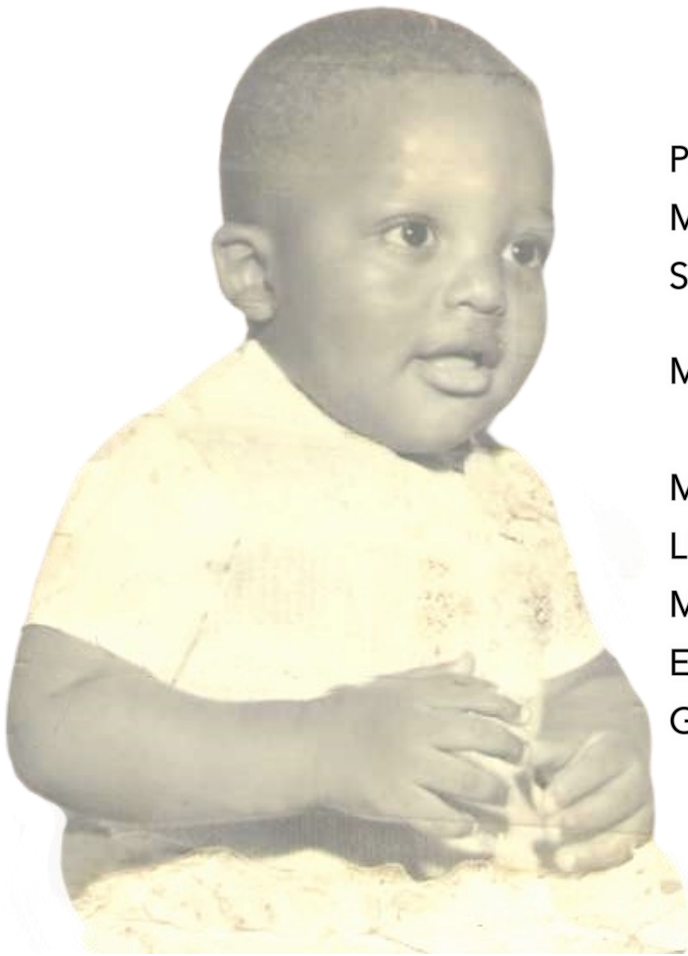
