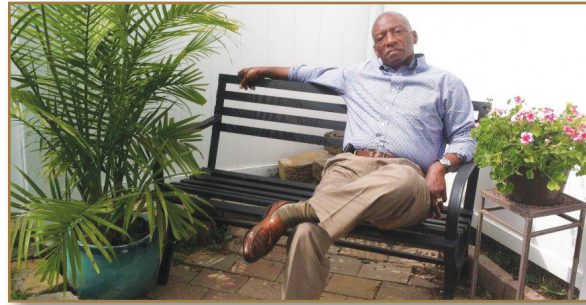

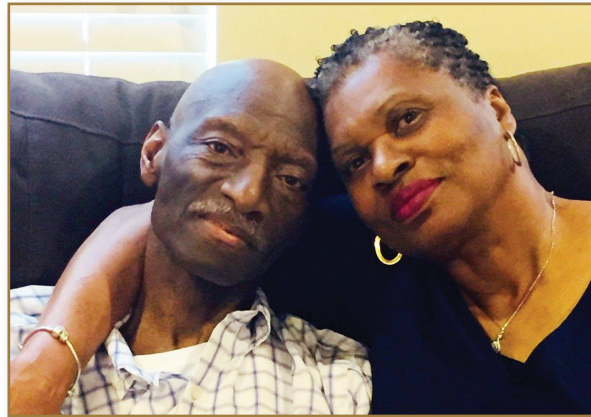

Obituary
