Janice Maria Edmonds, age 90, longtime resident of Pocatello, Idaho, passed away on November 19, 2025. She was born to Alvin L. Funk and Doris E. Mills Funk on May 19, 1935, in the American Falls hospital. She was raised in Aberdeen, Idaho, with many fond memories of those years growing up in a small town. She attended school and graduated from Aberdeen High School and was a member of the First Mennonite Church.

Janice married Wesley Edmonds and had three children: Daniel, Sharon, and Brent. They were a Navy family and moved several times, including living in Waukegan, Illinois, and San Diego, California. The two later divorced.

The children grew up in San Diego and that is where Janice began her career.
