

Daisy Beatrice Daniels was born July 6, 1944, in Waterproof, Louisiana, and peacefully departed this life on December 7, 2025. She was the third of nine children born to Albert and Pearlina Daniels. Daisy accepted Christ at Evergreen Baptist Church, where she was baptized in the river. She spent her formative years in Waterproof and graduated from Tensas Rosenwald High School.

In 1963, she moved to Houston and pursued a nursing education, working in healthcare for more than 50 years. Throughout her career, she became an active member of the Licensed Vocational Nurses Association of Texas, Houston Chapter, where she proudly served as president for over a decade.

On July 2, 1966, Daisy was united in holy matrimony to Charles Louis Sancho, and their union was blessed with one son, Charles Jerome Sancho. Daisy and Charles were among the first members of Mt. 




