And smiled with pride for all of you*

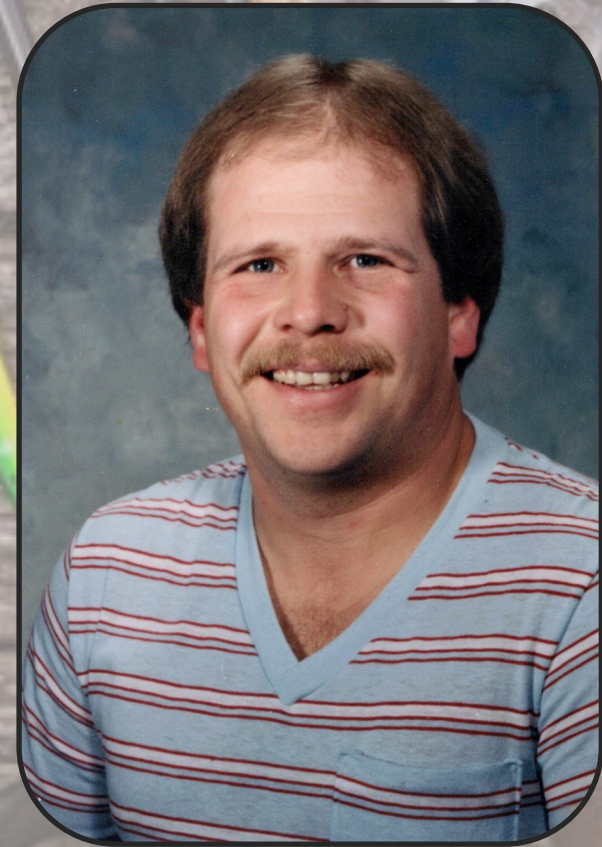
*So don't cry for me because life is done

# *Tim Hudson*

Herbert Timothy "Tim" Hudson, 69, of Green Ridge, passed away on Wednesday, May 8, 2024, at his home in Green Ridge. He was born on June 16, 1954, in Windsor, MO, the son of Herbert Roy Hudson and Bonnie Dene (Thacker) Hudson, who preceded him in death.
