

Alfonso Jackson's life began on August 25, 1968, in Dallas, Texas, at Parkland Memorial Hospital, as the son of Reverend Alvin and Doretha Jackson. In 1975, at the age of seven, he relocated to Las Vegas, Nevada, with his mother, younger brother Allen, and stepfather James. He attended True Love Baptist Church with his mother and graduated from El Dorado High School in 1987. Growing up on Comstock and Lake Mead, also known as 40 Block, he later found employment in 1992 with Superior Tile Co. in construction. Possessing a background as a street fighter and boxer, holding a black belt in MMA, Alfonso pursued a boxing career, achieving several titles, including Golden Gloves in the heavyweight division and the USA championship in both the heavyweight and super heavyweight divisions. His role models during his formative years were Muhammad Ali and Bruce Lee, and he aspired to compete in the Olympics. In June of 2000, Alfonso embraced Christianity and became associated with Kenneth Copeland Ministries. Following his commitment to Jesus, he embraced salvation and the Holy Spirit, becoming a devoted follower. On August 12, 2025, just 13 days before his 57th birthday.

Alfonso passed away, leaving behind a legacy of faith and accomplishment. He was preceded in death by his father, Alvin Jackson, and his brother Cedric Traylor. He is survived by his daughters, Tatiana Jackson and Aleayah Nellis; mother, Doretha Traylor; siblings, Allen Jackson, Yolanda Traylor, Marlon Traylor, James Traylor, and Patrick Traylor; four granddaughters, Armani, Amia, Nyla, Kehlani, and a multitude of family and friends.
