Isaac will join his grandfather, Samuel Ortiz in heaven.

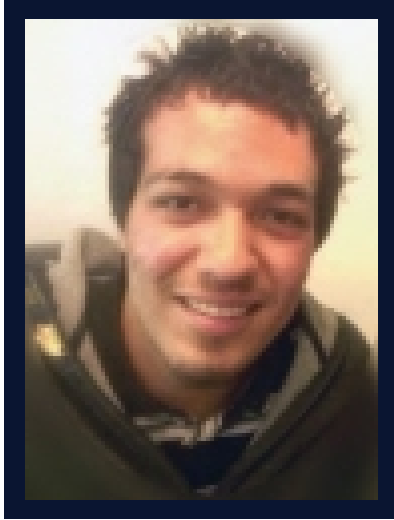
He will be missed and the memories of him will always be forever.
