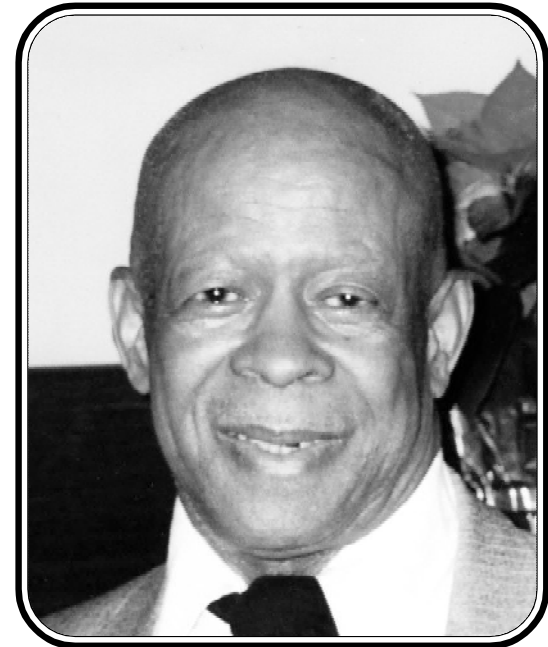

## Obituary
