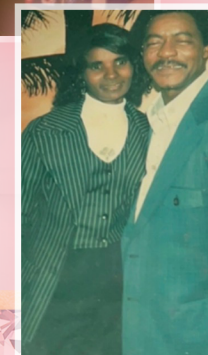
Ida's legacy and journey will be missed and cherished by all who knew her.
