I'm fishin' with the Master of the sea.*

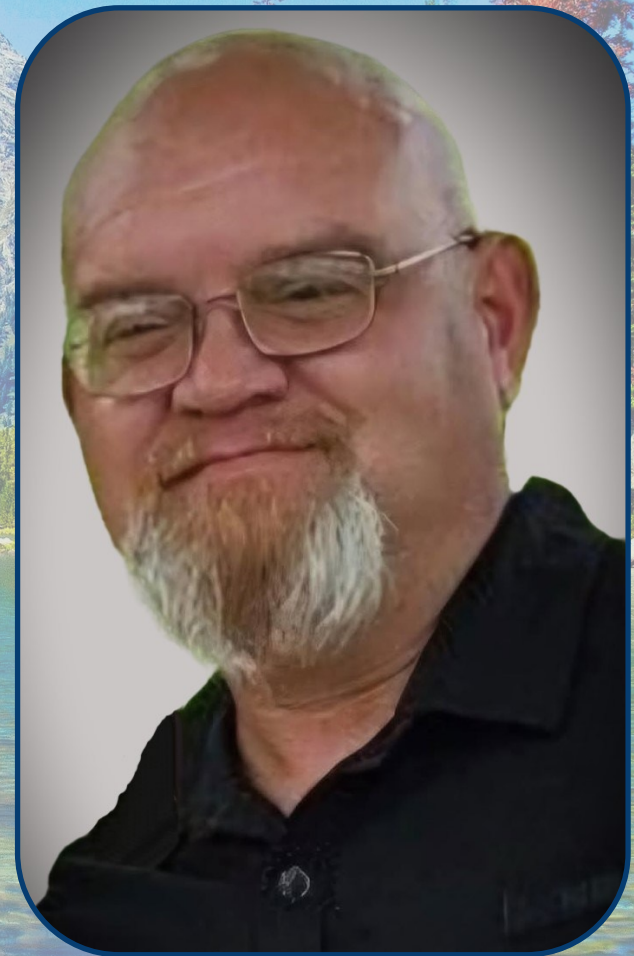
*We will miss each other for awhile,
