

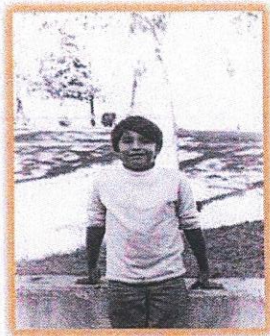
Allen was born to Irene Grace Middle Tent and Silas Ross Jr.

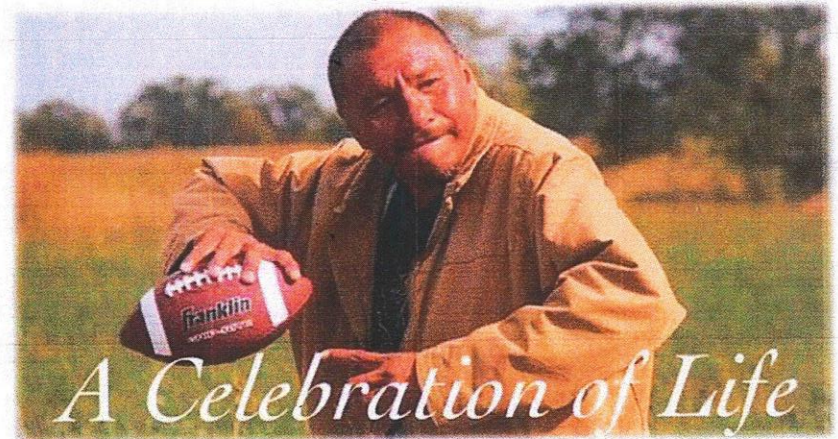
