


Her Story

Paulette Laverne Lisby (affectionately known as Pauley to her friends), 71, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania passed away of natural causes on December 26, 2023. She was born in Suffolk, Virginia in 1952 to Christine Lisby, a Single Mother, and was brought to Philadelphia as a toddler, where she suffered a broken hip bone at 2 years of age. Paulette gave birth to one child in spite of doctors telling her at eight, she may never be able to carry a child to term because of her previous hip injury.

My mother was so proud of her 1st job as a Candy Striper, age 16, at a Hospital, here in Philly. She later received her G.E.D. and was an alumni of Simon Gratz High. Mom also enjoyed driving the "Big Yellow Checkered Taxi Cab", in the 1970's. She went on to become a Yellow School Bus Attendant for the School District of Philadelphia, assisting students at Dunbar and Taggart elementary schools, with special needs in which she also enjoyed being able to help the children and was very proud and protective.

Paulette attended Berean Presbyterian Church in Philadelphia, "Enter to Worship, Leave to Serve." She also attended Church of the Advocate, "In Christ there is neither male or female, Bond nor free, Jew Nor Gentile, we are one." The City of Philadelphia, Department of Human Services is where Paulette retired some years ago.

Paulette was preceded in death by her loving mothers, Christine, Viola (foster mom), her grandmother, Geraldine Douglas; uncle, Bill; and brothers, Stewart, Ricardo and Stanley.

Paulette is survived by her daughter, Desiree, her grandchildren, Yonna, La-Quon and great grandchildren, Issaiah, Darius, Chloe and Amani.
