



## Our Mother's Love A Tribute to Kathie Wilson

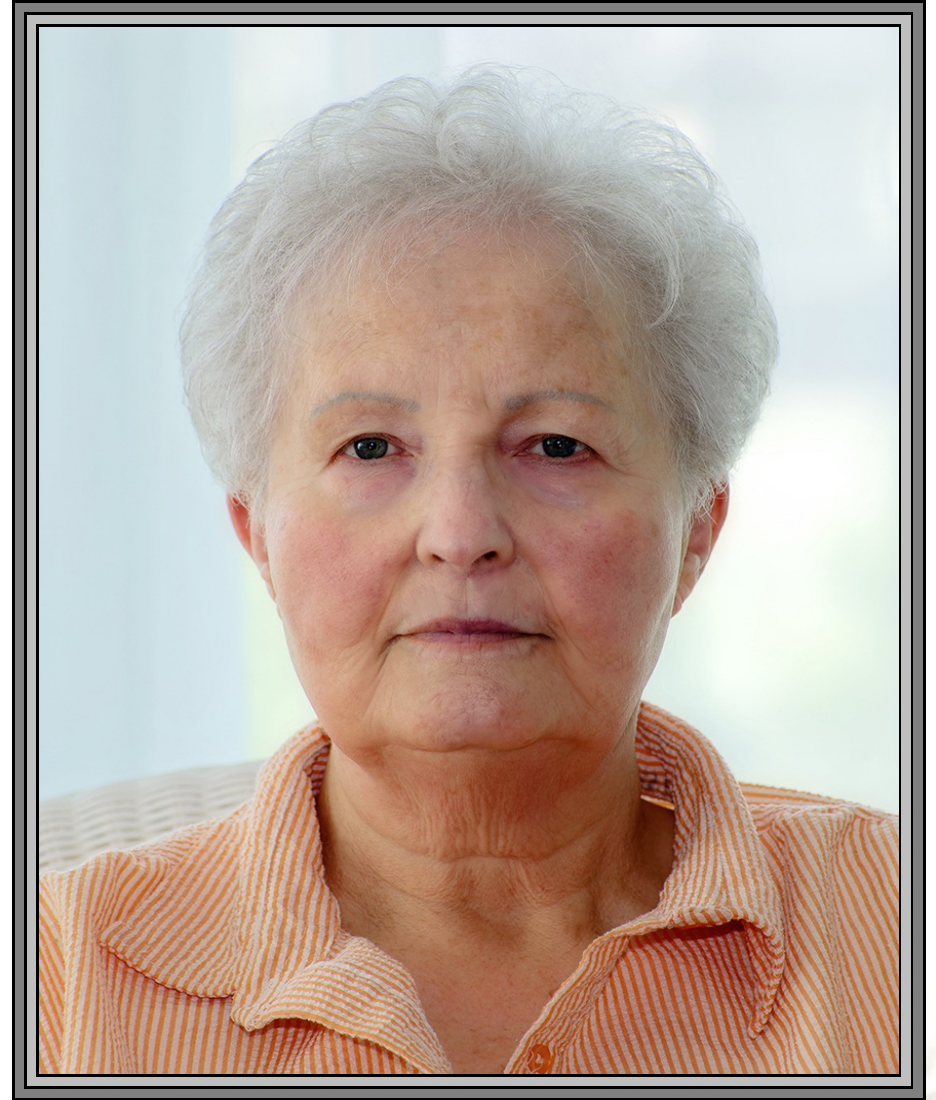
Her love is selfless, freely given
