soul.

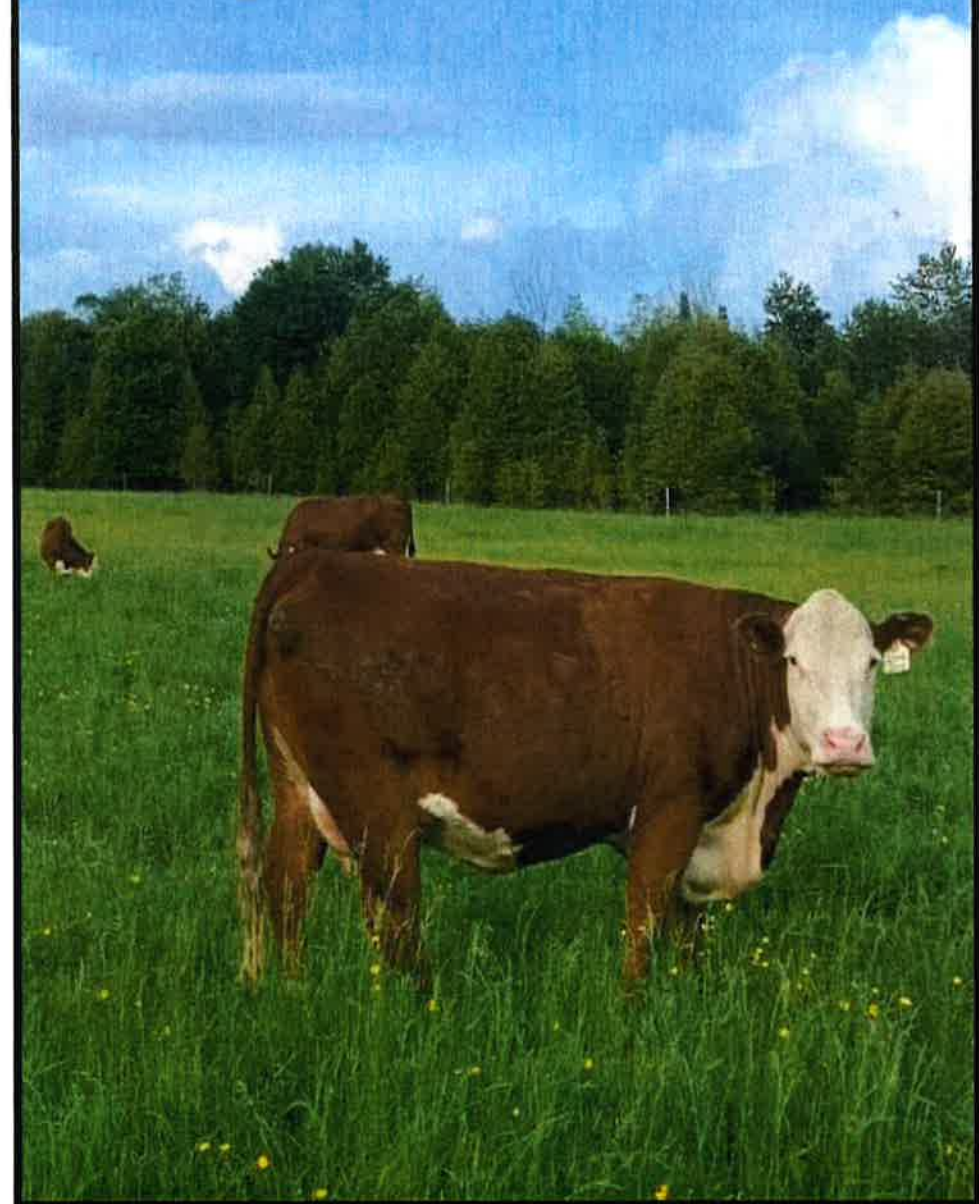
He leadeth me in the paths of righteousness
