Perhaps you sent a floral spray, if so, we saw it there.

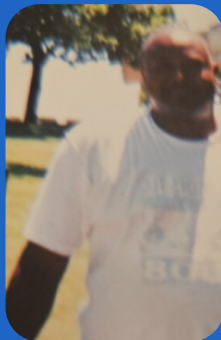
Perhaps you spoke the kindest words, as any friend could say.
