She was a member of the Morris Lions Club and Assumption Catholic Church where she served as Eucharistic Minister, lectured, sang in the choir and organized the September Fest for 20 years.

She was a dedicated wife, mother and grandmother. She was an excellent cook and baker and passed those skills on to her children and grandchildren. Flowers were her passion. She enjoyed assembling numerous pots each year to decorate her home and yard. She enjoyed many fishing and camping trips with Ron. She dearly loved her dogs taking them with her everywhere she went.

Corinne died Sunday, February 8, 2026, at her home surrounded by her loving family. She was 73 years old. For nearly 10 years, she courageously endured Progressive Supranuclear Palsy, a degenerative neurological disease.
