"WELCOME HOME"*



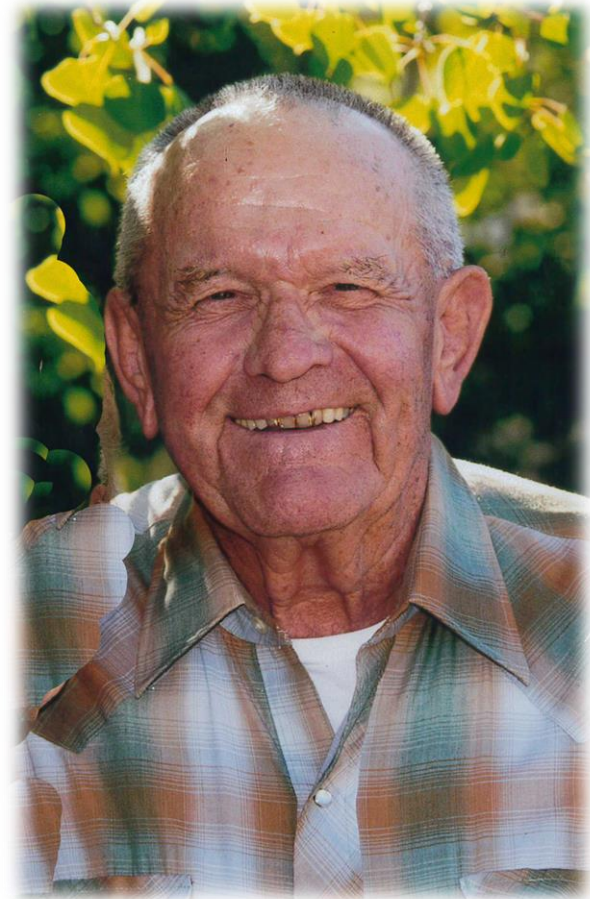
