## Obituary

Julian David Lesmes Prada was born in Bogotá, Colombia on May 7, 2001, and entered into eternal rest on August 15, 2025. He passed away surrounded by his loved ones at the University of Cincinnati Medical Center.

Julian attended school in Bogotá, where he made many lifelong friends. As a child, he was described by his grandmother as attentive, caring, calm, curious, and very bright. He shared a very special bond with her – she lovingly cared for him when he was sick, spoke with his teachers, and guided him throughout his childhood. He had a deep affection for her, and their closeness was evident to everyone.

From an early age, Julian also had the love and support of his aunts, who helped raise him. His Aunt Paola remembered him arriving as a baby and becoming part of their household. He was a calm and sensible child, and the whole family was happy to welcome him. He often helped his grandmother in the kitchen and once even joined her at work on the sewing machines during a school break. His Aunt Magda (who he fondly called “Hermanita” recalled how, when Julian was about eight months old, he came to live with them. Though the family worked long hours, she devoted herself to caring for him and treasured those years together. These bonds with his aunts and grandmother shaped him into the loving and generous man he became.

Julian’s mother lovingly remembered him as a kind, sociable, generous, and free-spirited soul who united those around him and was always willing to help anyone in need.

Adventurous by nature, Julian had always dreamed of traveling the world. As a teenager, he lived in several countries including Colombia, Peru, Bolivia, and Chile, building strong connections with people and nature. During these years, he learned about the world through his travels, and “nature” became his greatest teacher.

Julian’s favorite colors were blue, yellow, and black. He embraced many cultures and cuisines, especially enjoying Uncle Mike’s oxtail and curried goat from Jamaica, ceviche from Peru, and sancocho from Colombia. Music was another passion of his, with a deep love for genres such as cumbia and reggae. He especially admired the legendary Bob Marley. He was also an avid fan of Club Independiente Santa Fe, a Columbian professional football team based on Botoga.

Julian was an incredible person and a beautiful soul. He will always be remembered for his smile, his dancing, and his ability to enjoy life and bring joy to others no matter the circumstances.

Julian leaves behind to cherish his memory his beloved fiancée, Vanessa; two daughters, Sofia and Lucia; his brothers, Anyesson, Cristian, Santiago, and Alejandro; his mother and father; grandmother; aunts; extended relatives in Colombia; and countless friends both in the United States and around the world.

He will be forever loved, deeply missed and we will remember him with happiness.
