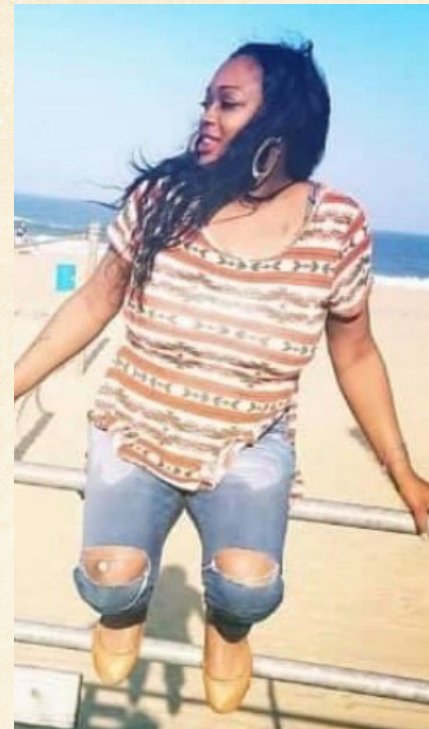


Precious Memories

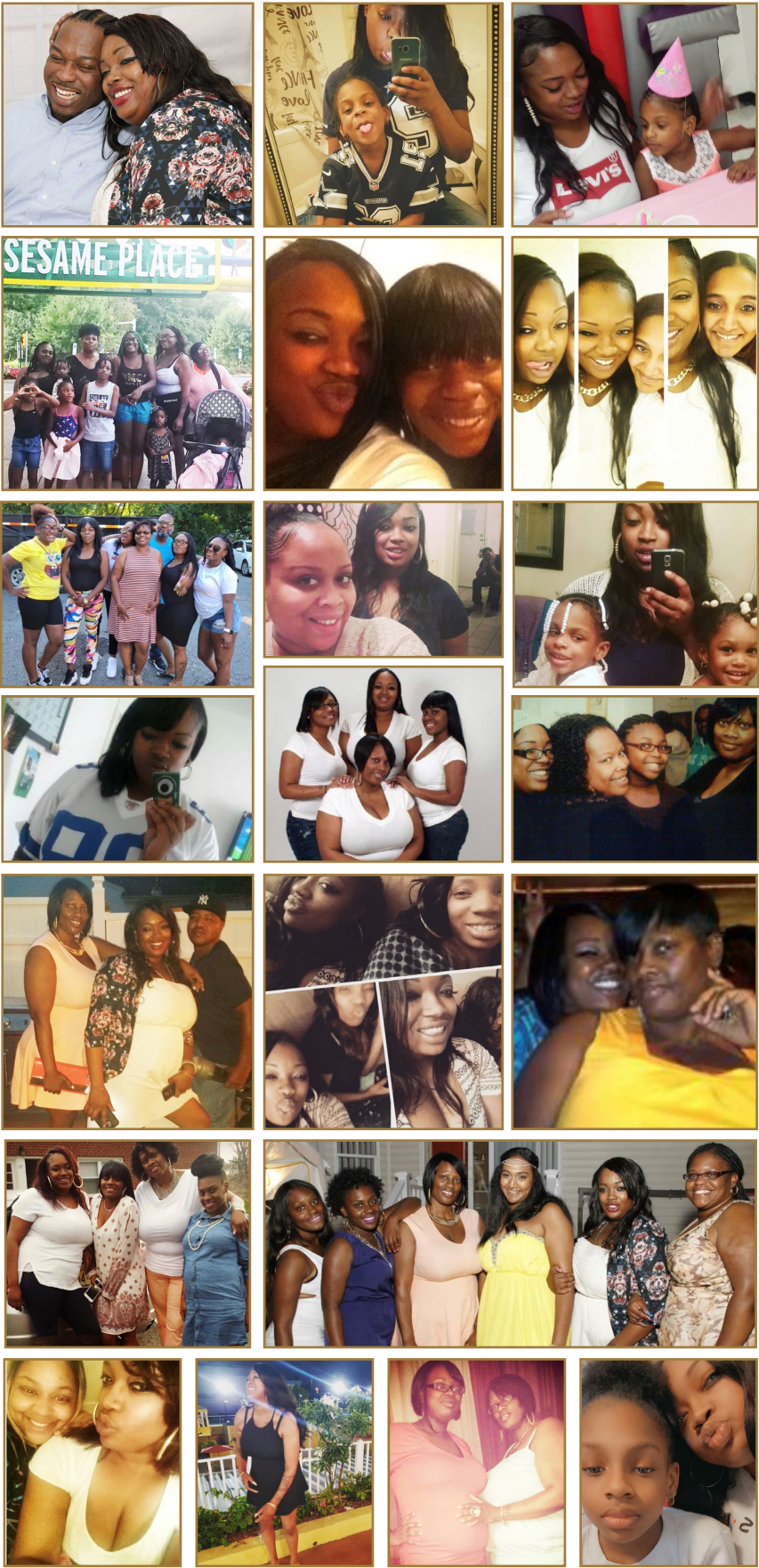
