

Tre shared the last eight years of his life with his Lovebird, Lisa, whose devotion and unconditional love meant the world to him.

Tre possessed a natural charisma and a gift for storytelling, bringing memories to life so vividly you felt as if you were walking alongside him. A daredevil at heart and big kid in spirit, he loved roller coasters, gaming, gardening, nature, and time spent laughing with family and friends. He enjoyed good debates, inspirational podcasts, and meaningful conversations about life, goals, and fatherhood.

A passionate truck driver for over 16 years, Tre earned his CDL in 2011 and proudly logged over one million miles, earning membership in the Million Mile Club with a spotless driving record. As he often proudly said, "I get the job done." He navigated the country with an atlas because he didn't always trust the GPS and traveled through more than 40 states, collecting shot glasses from each one. In 2019, he achieved a lifelong dream by purchasing his truck, "The Road Runner," and founding JAWS Transport LLC, named after his daughters Juliette and Alayla Williams, with the company logo designed by Amiaya.

Tre's greatest joy was building meaningful moments with his children, teaching, encouraging, and celebrating their gifts and milestones. He showed love through action, thoughtfulness, and attention to the little things, always ready to lend a hand or offer support. Even while facing recent health challenges, he made it a point to uplift others and do at least one good deed each day.

Tre embraced taking chances, getting back up, and living with no regrets. His contagious personality, steady determination, and deep love for his family will be deeply missed. Though his earthly shift has ended, he would tell us to "miss me with all that crying." His legacy lives on in the stories he told, the values he modeled, and the way he reminded those around him to always get the job done.
