

Lillian S. Conway, "Peachie", 81, of Coatesville, PA was called home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, June 1, 2022, at home. She was born in Coatesville, PA on August 8, 1940, to the late Jane (Barber) Conway and James Clifton Conway.

Peachie attended Passtown Elementary School, James Adams School, and was a 1959 graduate from S. Horace Scott Senior High School. She worked at many different hospitals throughout her career including Embreeville State Hospital and Chester County. Peachie was a very stylish woman and enjoyed catalog shopping. She had an amazing amount of clothes, shoes and accessories.


Peachie loved spending time with and being surrounded by her grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
