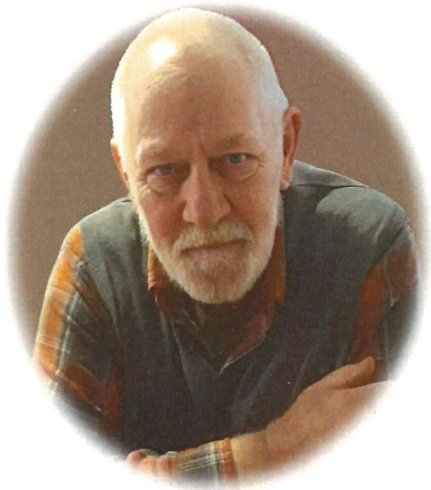
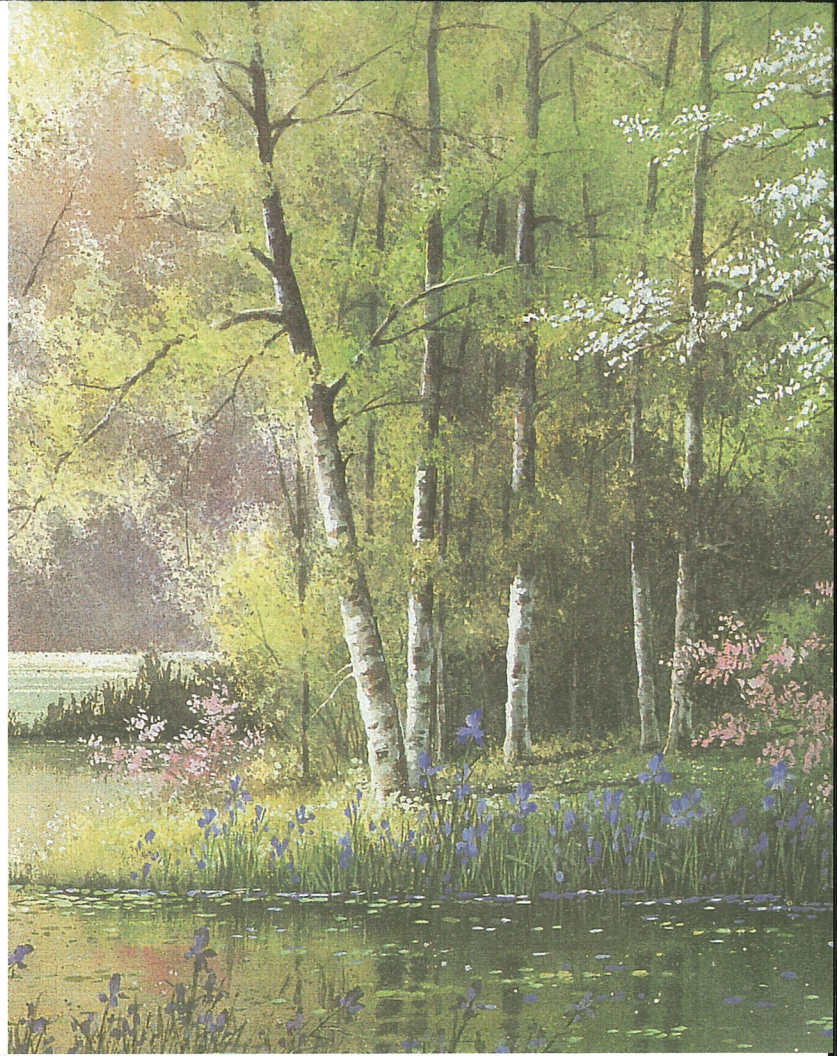

Gerald "Jerry" Volker, 80, passed away unexpectedly at his home in Hill City, MN, on Sunday, February 2, 2025.

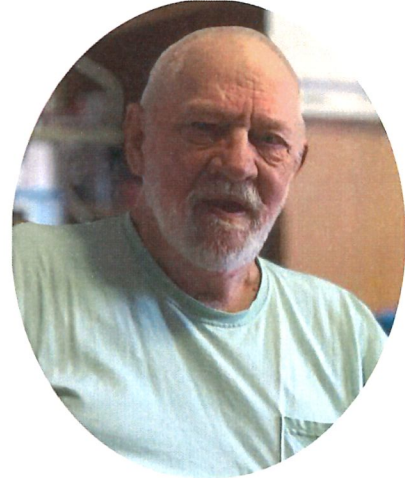
He is preceded in death by his parents, great-granddaughter Makenzlee, brothers Darryle and infant brother John Jay, and sister Virginia Duncan.
