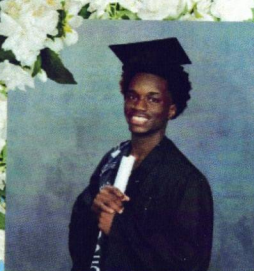
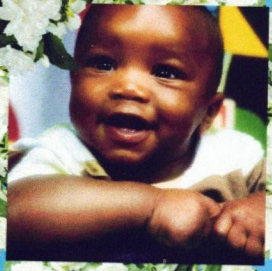

Khadyn excelled in every grade and proudly graduated from Hamilton High School in 2025. He was planning to attend college, something he talked about often.

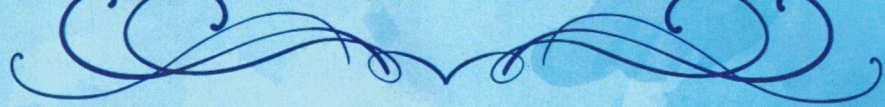

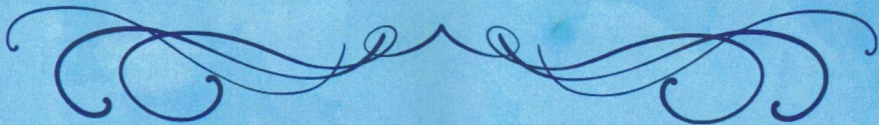
