

His Life Reflections

Robert H. Moore, Jr., affectionately known as “Bob Moore”, was born to Robert H. Moore, Sr. and Mary Frances Gamble (Moore) on April 4, 1945, in Huddy, Kentucky. He transitioned this life to be with the Lord on October 14, 2025.

Bob graduated from Liberty High School Class of 1963 in Williamson, West Virginia. After graduation, he enlisted into the United States Navy and served from October 1964 to October 1968. He also served in the Army Reserves from March 21, 1975 to October 1989. He was employed with the United States Postal Service for 42 years before retiring in 2009.

Bro. Bob was a man of many passions. He had a passion for driving which led to his driving for COTA and later for Columbus City Schools as a Bus Driver. If you needed your car worked on, he was your guy. Bob was a lover of cars and gave great advice on what to buy and how to keep it running like a charm. He was affectionately called “God’s Sound Man” and faithfully served in the audio ministry at Gospel Lighthouse Church. He was a stickler for making sure the sound booth was well equipped, organized and ensured that the audio inventory was always up-to-date, and equipment well maintained. He took pride in being punctual and available to render services when needed and was the fix-it guru when repair issues arose. He loved being an integral part of the Men's Fishing Ministry and GLC's Youth Ministry. Bob loved the Lord, his family and adored his grandchildren and great grandchildren . He was proud of his Military service to this country and loved engaging in conversations about his military experiences. After many years of faithful service, he transitioned his membership to Linden Life Fellowship.

He is predeceased in death by his parents, Robert H. Moore, Sr. and Mary Frances Gamble (Moore).
